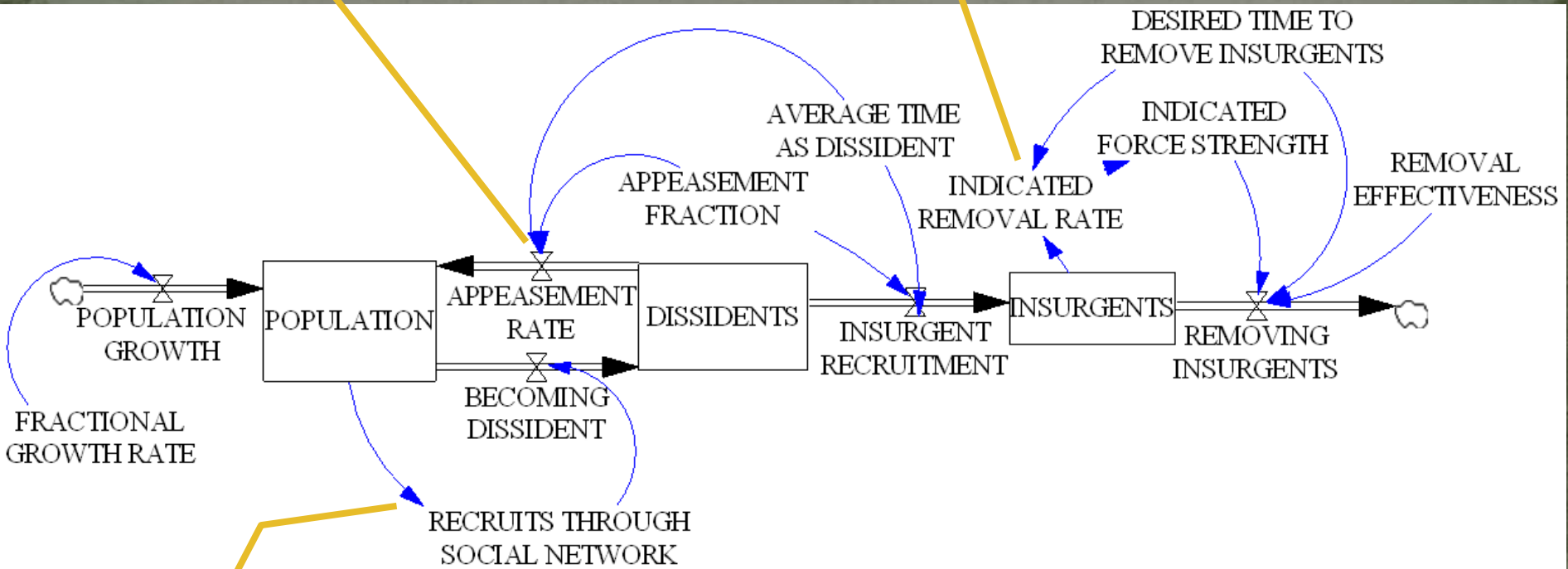

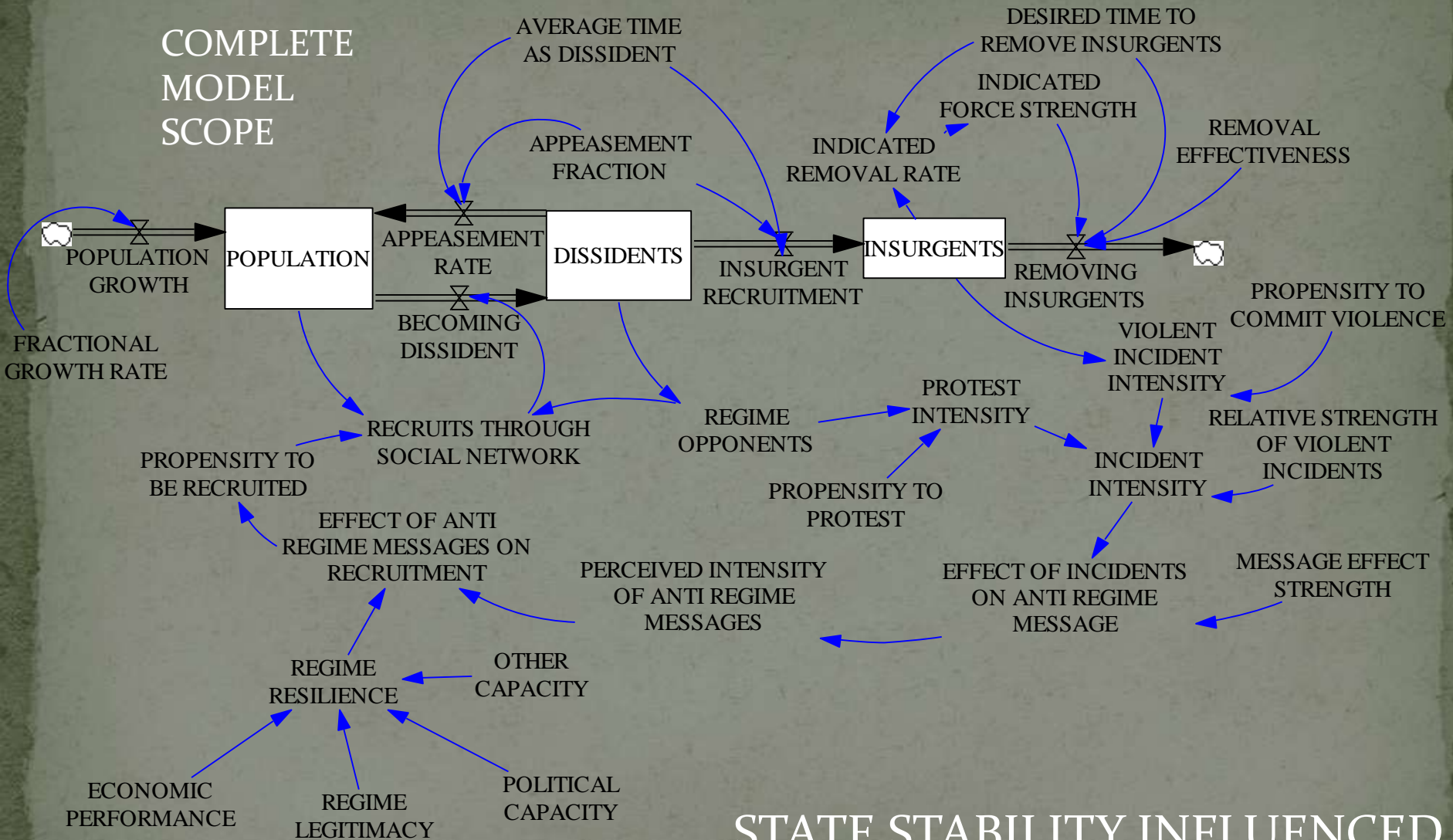

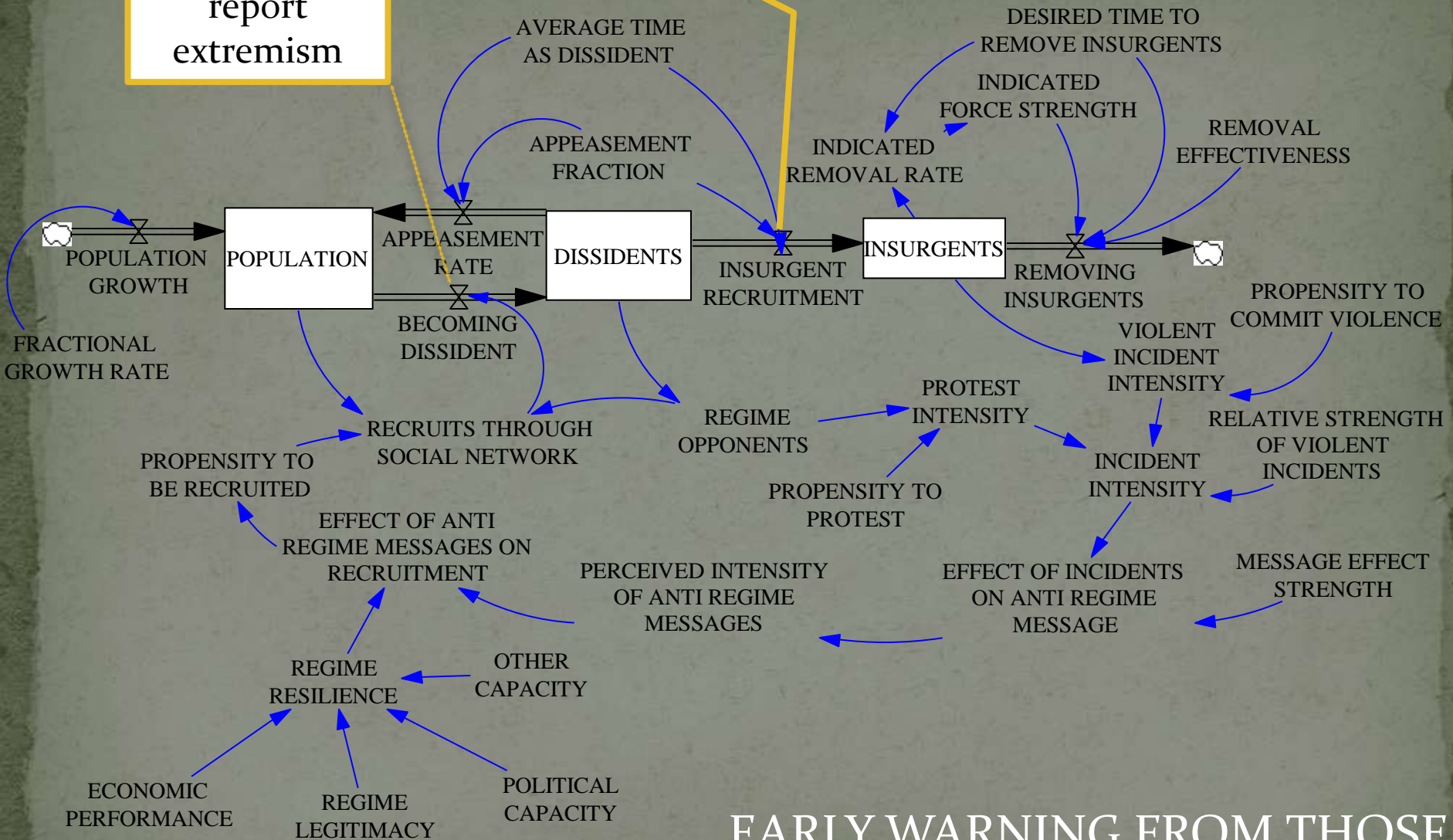

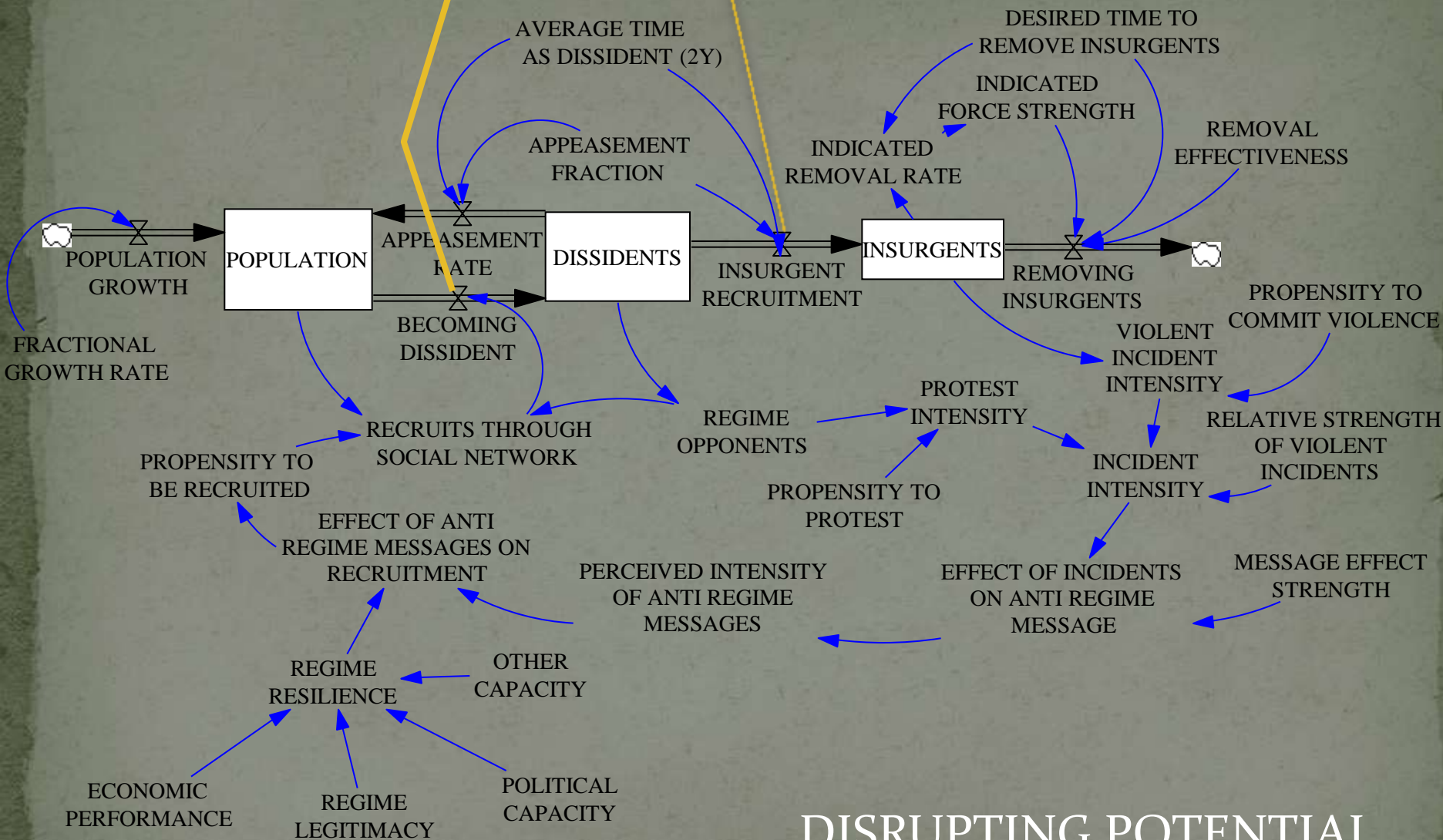
STATE STABILITY INFLUENCED BY LARGE SOCIO-TECHNICAL SYSTEM

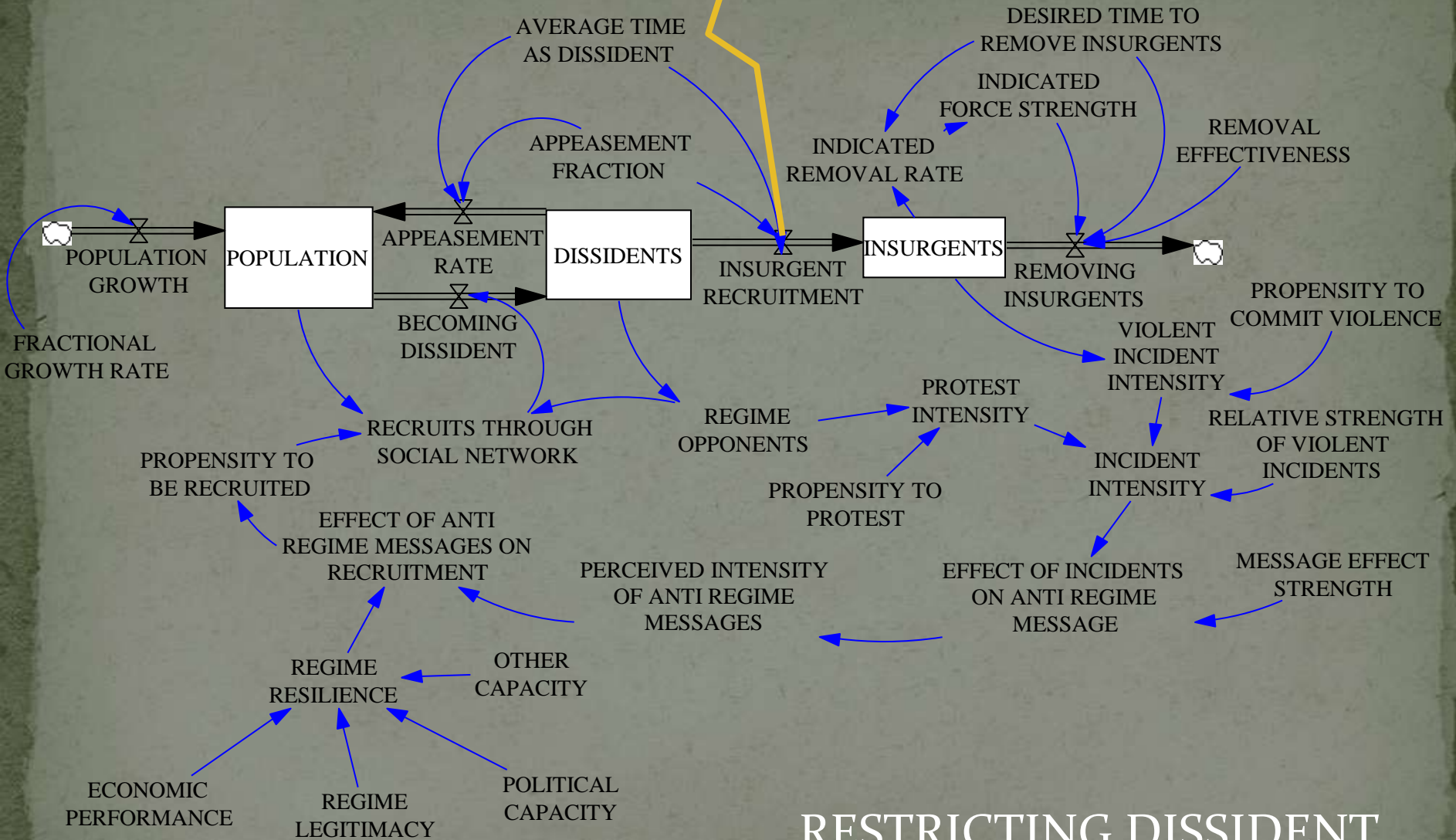

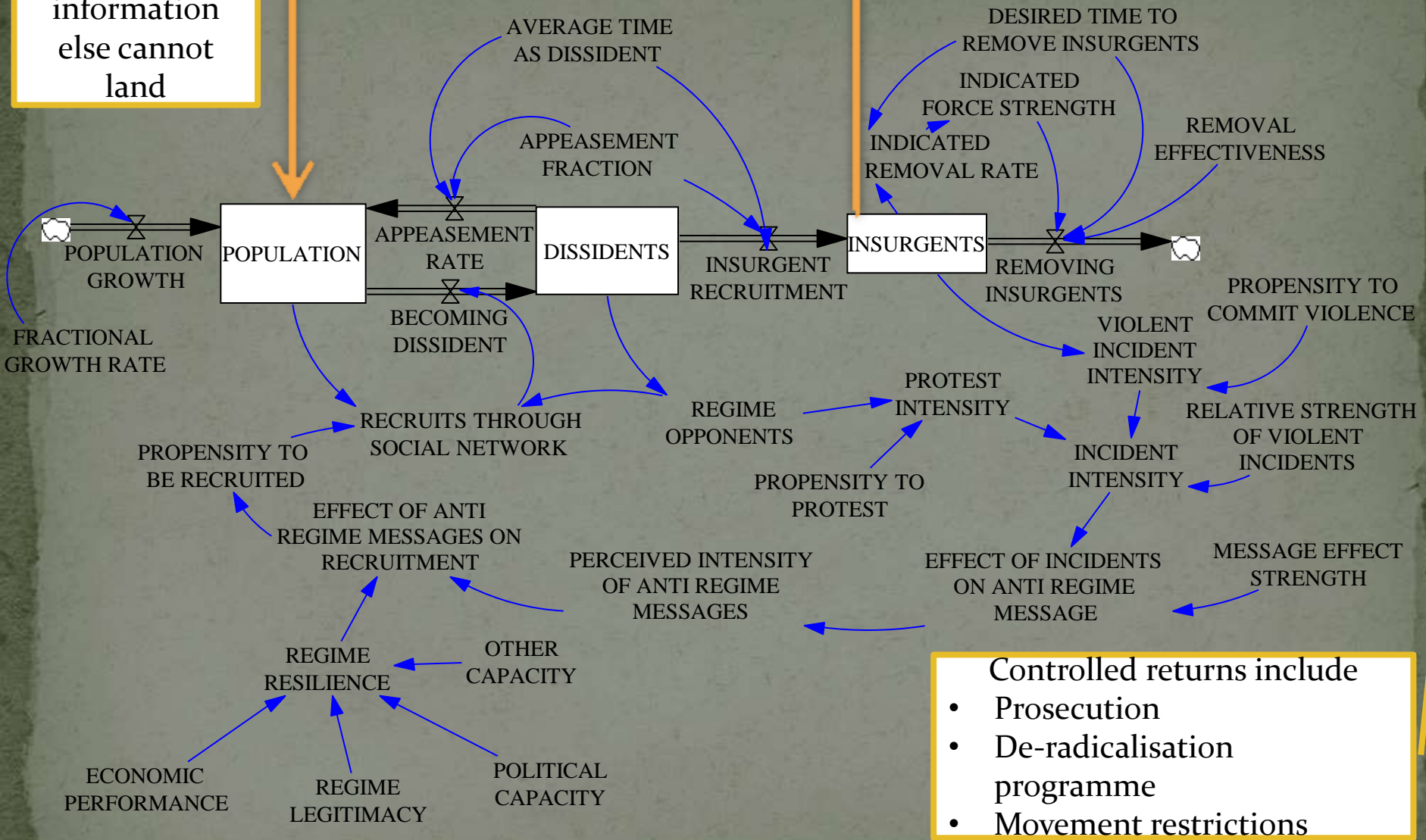

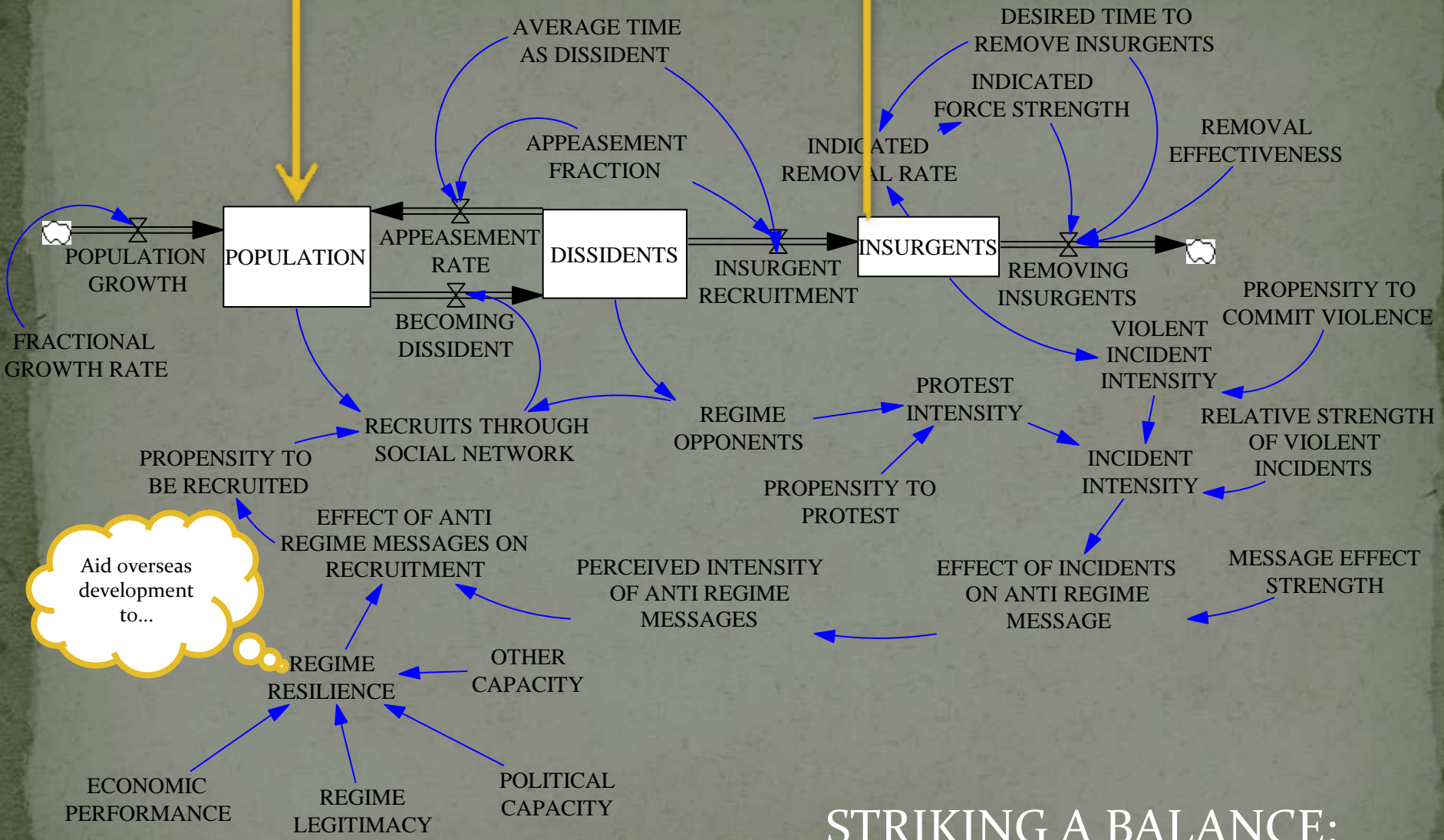
Summary
